Serving through New International

Elizabeth's ministry is focused on wound care for individuals needing care beyond what is available while Lance provides support and appropriate technology which improves life for the poor. Much of his work is done in a handicap training center, building things like rocket stoves, small transition homes for homeless, and making supplies to both sterilize wounds and control Covid-19. He also provides support and expertise to churches and other ministries which helps them advance their reach. Both use their contacts to share the gospel.

Their mission is to provide a conduit to connect people of faith, those that have needs in the Dominican Republic with those in the US seeking appropriate opportunities to engage in a wide variety of mission work.

FPI works with more than 80 churches in the DR to provide mentoring of pastors, development of church leaders, and assistance for church growth activities, physical improvements, food and clean water for the congregation and nearby community. FPI also provides food, education, and material assistance to the “The Good Samaritan Orphanage.”

FPI’s Hope and a Future Women’s Program provides vocational training for at-risk single mothers and Christian education programs for their children in remote and economically depressed communities. They also have a Youth Leadership Training

In 2020 FPI’s priorities temporarily shifted to focus on issues related to COVID-by providing food and medicine to their pastors and their families and those in need within their congregations.

- That those suffering from poverty and life-threatening health issues related to COVID-19 will find relief.

(5) Operation Christmas Child (A Ministry of Samaritan's Purse)



Operation Christmas Child



Operation Christmas Child partners with churches worldwide to reach boys and girls with the gospel. Every gift-filled shoebox is a tool for evangelism and discipleship for a local church. Many of these children have never before received a present or heard the true meaning of Christmas—until they open a gift-filled shoebox from a person like you. At Operation Christmas Child outreach events, boys and girls hear the Good News of the Lord Jesus Christ and receive a tangible expression of God's love through one of your prayerfully packed shoeboxes.

After receiving the shoebox gifts, many children are discipled through a 12-lesson program, *The Greatest Journey*, where they learn how to become more faithful followers of Jesus and how to share their faith with others.

OCC has delivered shoebox gifts and shared the Gospel with millions of children in over 160 countries and territories. In the last couple of years, they've expanded their efforts to remote Pacific islands and unreached ethnic groups.

The Southwest Florida Regional Juvenile Detention Center is a 62-bed, secure facility that serves youth detained by various circuit courts. The facility provides supervision of youth in a safe, secure and humane environment. Their services include: education, mental health, substance abuse, and health care. New

Hope volunteers visit the jail each week to address God's view on topics such as decision making, forgiveness, real love, overcoming temptation, stealing, and more.

Every Monday afternoon a small group of women from New Hope go to visit the Juvie Jail to share with the small group of girls that are there. They usually bring cookies and lemonade, share some stories, read Scripture and give a short Bible lesson and then have prayer with the girls. Each of the girls is given the opportunity to share a prayer request.

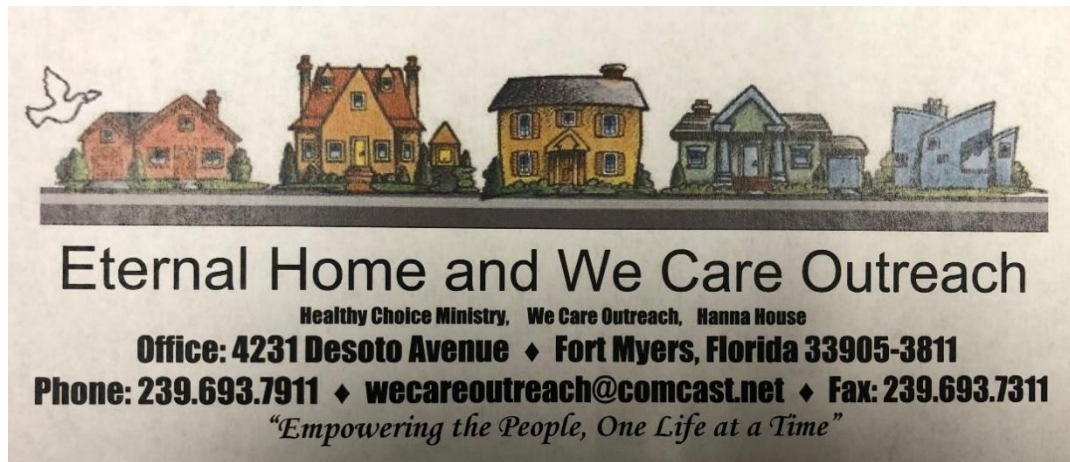
